

Every year BNSF makes significant investments to enhance and expand our network to meet the growing needs of our customers for efficient, reliable rail service.






In 2024, BNSF made **\$3.7 billion in** capital investments, including completing a multiyear project to add 50 miles of double track in Kansas, reducing travel time for some trains by 90 minutes.

2024 service improvements include:

Nearly 1 in 5 BNSF employees has served in a branch of the **U.S. Armed Forces.**






STEWARDSHIP

Freight trains are **3-4X more** fuel-efficient than their highway counterparts.


